



## CODE OF CONDUCT

***You and your team are expected:***

### **Attendance:**

- To fulfil your obligation to attend and compete in all official SLKPA matches to the best of your ability.
- Should attend the venue before the scheduled start time, and be ready to compete promptly on time.

### **Contact:**

- Maintain a watch on the SLKPA website for all important dates and announcements.
- Notify the League Secretary if your team's main contact email or mobile details change.

### **Playing:**

- Be respectful to your opponents. Be respectful to the venue. Be respectful to the equipment.
- Never coach.
- Never use excessive barracking or position yourself in order to put an opponent off.
- Never concede a frame. It is not a singles competition and not your frame to concede, as the frame result may have a bearing on other teams in the division.

### **Refereeing:**

- To learn the rules and the normal duties of the referee and timekeeper.
- To focus totally on the frame you are refereeing or timekeeping, including taking up different positions to get the best view of shots being played.
- Not to be engage in talking to other team mates, opponents, using mobile phones etc.
- No one but the referee and time keeper and occasionally team captains need to have any input whatsoever into refereeing decisions. If an agreement cannot be reached then contact your divisional secretary for a ruling.

### **Adminstration:**

- Text results to your divisional secretary immediately after the match.
- Inform your divisional secretary of any notable performers immediately after the match, to be included in the weekly media report.
- Submit all result sheets and other SLKPA documentation on time and in an eligible manner.

### **General:**

- Members should refrain from disrespecting the League and its members at all times.
- To know the Rules of the SLKPA, and adhere to the Code Of Conduct.
